Welcome new E.C.D.R. Members!!

This page is designed to help you get familiar with our club and it's rules.

The first track originally built in the late 1960's was a flat track followed soon after by a Motocross track. In 1988 we formed a legal corporation and formally purchased the land. In 1989 the club house trailer was bought, the parking lot was graveled and bleachers and lap counting stands were built. In 1990 the club constructed a second Motocross track and a water well was drilled. Starting gates were installed in 1992 and in 1994 the Super-cross track was built. In 2003 we installed a sprinkler system and then in the spring of 2008 our old club house trailer was removed and a new club house was built.

Club meetings are held the 2nd Tuesday of every month in the basement of the Taco Treat/Amigo Lounge. It is important for members to make as many meeting as possible to help in the decision making and to voice thoughts and concerns that will help make your club and track the best it can be!

Track Rules

1. Riders must wear helmet and over the ankle protection when riding.
2. Buddy system riding only.
3. Adults must accompany children under the age of 14.
4. No riding while under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
5. All pets must be on a leash.
6. No alterations of the tracks.
7. No autos or trucks on the tracks.
8. No riding in the pits or parking areas.
9. Members are responsible for guests.
10. No firearms or fireworks allowed.
11. Make sure that you **lock the gate** when you enter the track and when you leave the track.
12. Please help keep the area clean. Don't litter, pick up trash and use the dumpsters.
13. The club is not responsible for accidents, damage, and lost or stolen property.
14. Do not use the concrete starting gates. They are for state races and Wednesday nighters only.
15. No open burning. Fire must be contained in a barrel.
16. Disregard for the Track rules could result in membership termination.

Dues & Work Hours

All day riders are required to pay \$25.00 fee and complete the ECDR Day Ride Application and release. As a member of ECDR it is your responsibility to ensure and enforce that all riders are either members or have signed the day rider application.

Single Membership - \$180.00 10 work hours required – 4 hours of 10 required at the state race

Family Membership - \$200.00 20 work hours required - 4 hours of 20 required at the state race

Non Working – Single \$350.00 / **Family** \$400.00 Non-voting member – No work hours required

Work hours may be accomplished in a variety of ways such as grounds clean up, work projects, preparing for races and most importantly working on race days with flagging, lap counting, scoring, sign ups and many others. **It is mandatory to work 4 of your hours at the State Race.** A Work Hours Tally Sheet has been included in this packet and you can find more copies in the clubhouse or online at www.ecdr.org/Join-Us. Once you have completed work hours, fill out the sheet and have it signed by a Club Officer. The sheets can be turned in to a club officer or at club meetings. Your hours will be recorded.
